DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The journey of COMMON WEALTH came into being at a pivotal and tumultuous period of my life. What started out as a writing and directing commission turned into something far more personal and evolutionary than I ever anticipated.

Having experienced a nervous breakdown in 2020 while living in Italy during COVID, the depths of depression that ensued (for several years) left me hopeless for the future. As a father of two children, I felt helpless to change the course of direction that society was seemingly taking—and, that bothered me. It was obvious the world was in pain. Those around me were struggling, as was I. Financially. Mentally. Socially. Most seemingly trying to hold it together with a brave face.

But, why? Why was this happening? And importantly, what could we do about it?

Up until that moment, my background as a writer/director/producer had been 100% in drama—not documentaries. Faced with the task of creating a relevant and poignant feature film on the subject of wealth inequality, economics and politics; I wondered how I could do so in a way that brought people together. I didn't want to make *another* film on the pros and cons of capitalism or socialism. I didn't want to make a film that was politically divisive. I wanted to create something that was unique, truly global, unifying, and that offered plausible solutions to the status quo with a sense of heart and soul.

As I mulled my options for a protagonist, I kept asking myself—*would my story be relevant? Would people connect through my lens?* I shrugged it off a number of times. I wondered if I was crazy for even considering the possibility. The idea of being in front of the camera seemed both ridiculous and unrealistic. A notoriously private person sharing their vulnerabilities and imperfections on film—*yeah, right*—I thought.

As months passed, it became evident that this film was nothing short of divine timing. The circumstances in my life had led me to this very moment. I'd acquired a position of empathy I did not possess until the hardships of life had slapped me with reality. I was in fact meant to be the one to tell this story. I had lived a life of many traumas, and this film was the opportune moment to share those experiences as a reminder to others that they're not alone.

Given the extremely personal nature of my story, I did however want to produce it on my own terms. Something that I deemed was artistically pure. Something without an agenda—or I felt it would be disingenuous. As a family, we self-financed the lion's share of the production budget, with the remainder coming from a long list of non-institutional, non-NGO, and non-government affiliated donors.

I'm extremely grateful for the experience. It opened my eyes to the possibilities of which our society could function with greater dignity. Importantly, it restored the hope I was longing for. It's my wish that the film serves as a gentle reminder that irrespective of the intricacies of economic and political systems, when we collectively choose selflessness over selfishness, that's when we'll see a revolution.

WRITER/DIRECTOR/PRODUCER

In 2011, Kane was Australia's youngest ever network television director, helming the long running series, *HOME AND AWAY* for the Seven Network. After a number of years developing films, remakes and other notable IP in the US (including *THE PHANTOM*, and the Michael Caine/Anthony Quinn/James Mason 1974 thriller, *THE DESTRUCTORS*), Guglielmi's frustration with the studio system led him to self-funding and directing his debut indie film, *COOPED UP*, which was later acquired by Sony Pictures & CSS Ent in the US as a CRACKLE ORIGINAL. After taking a six-year break to raise a family, Guglielmi returned in 2023 to produce his first feature length documentary, *COMMON WEALTH*, filmed across eight countries on the subject of unity and wealth inequality. He spent 2024 researching in the US and writing the screenplay, *THE GROUNDBREAKER*—a nineteenth century epic rags to riches tale based on a true story set in America's West.

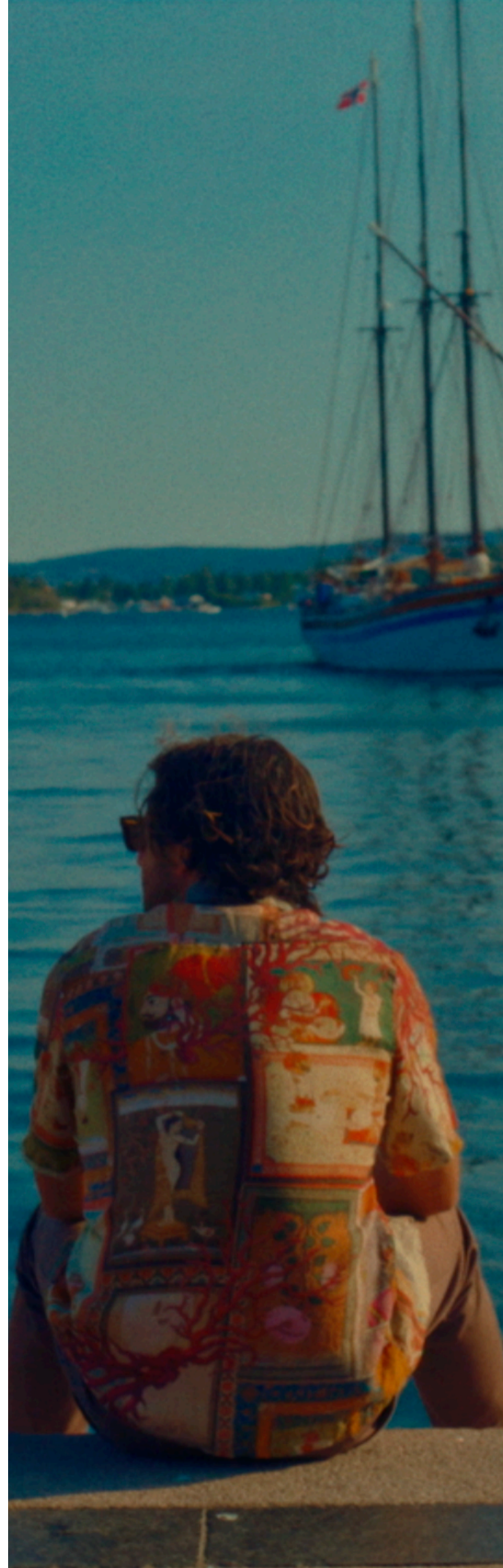
